Dear Commissioner Tam:

Please find enclosed additional information that has been supplied to the Forsyth County Board of Ethics in regards to the Ethics Complaint that has been filed against you.

Pursuant to Board of Ethics internal procedures if the Board determines that it will accept additional evidence, the party against whom the complaint was made will have additional time to respond to the additional materials.

As communicated in the original letter dated May 6, 2010 and pursuant to Section 14 of the Forsyth County Code of Ethics, upon receipt of a complaint alleging misconduct, the county official or employee against whom the complaint was filed may reply to the complaint within 30 days, unless such time for reply is extended by the Board of Ethics upon good cause shown. The response of the county official or employee must be supported by affidavits based on personal knowledge, must set forth such facts as would be admissible in evidence, and must show affirmatively that the affiant is competent to testify to the matters stated therein. All documents referred to in an affidavit should be attached to the affidavit.
